The John B Nixon Cup is awarded to the best exhibit in Class A1

The Dafforn Cup is awarded to the best exhibit in Classes A2 & A3

The Paxford Plate is awarded to the Flower Club winners of Class A4

Guidelines:

- Use any natural plant material, including dyed or dried plants but not artificial
- Exhibits spaces are 2'6" wide and 2'3" deep
- The height should not exceed 3'
- You may use other complementary accessories such as bases, drapes and/ or containers in your display
- Water will be available on the day
- Classes A2-3 must be assembled on site

CLASS

- A2 "An Exhibit" Include your own title on or near the display
- A3 "My Favourite Pastime" Floral design around this title

A4 "You Are Invited...."

A table decoration – table size approx 6ft x 2ft 3in, to be viewed from the front. Maximum height 3ft
