

SECTION A – FLOWER ARRANGING

The John B. Nixon Cup is awarded for the Best Exhibit in Class A1

The Dafforn Cup is awarded for the Best Exhibit from Classes A2 & A3

The Paxford Plate is awarded to the Flower Club winners of Class A4

Guidelines:

- Use any natural plant materials, including dyed or dried plants but not artificial.
- Exhibits spaces for Classes A2 and A3 are 2'6" wide and 2'3" deep.
- You may use other complementary accessories such as bases, drapes and/or containers in your display.
- Water will be available on the day.
- Classes A2, A3 and A4 must be assembled on site.

BEGINNERS CLASS

- A1 "In the Pink"
Space allowed: Width 18", Depth 18", Height unlimited
May be brought ready-assembled if required.

CLASSES

- A2 "On the Beach"
Space allowed: Width 2'6", Depth 2'3",
Height unlimited
- A3 "Fireworks"
An exhibit. Space Allowed: Width 2'6", Depth 2'3",
Height unlimited

FLOWER CLUBS

- A4 "A TV Programme"
A table exhibit. Title to be included. Space allowed: Width 6ft, Depth 2'3", Height unlimited
No plant material to over-hang the sides. Own table covering may be used.
