

SECTION B - SWEET PEAS

The Sweet Pea Cup – is awarded for the Best Exhibit in Section B

The National Sweet Pea Society's Oxidised Bronze Medal is awarded to the exhibitor with the most points in Section B

The Banksian Medal, kindly given by the Royal Horticultural Society, is awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in Sections B, C, D, E, G & H. An exhibitor may not win the medal more than once in three consecutive years. In the event of a tie, the committee will decide the winner.

Guidelines:

- Vases and water will be provided on the day.
- No wiring allowed.

CLASSES

- B1 Six Vases of Sweet Peas – each vase containing 12 spikes of a single named variety, each vase a different variety
- B2 Three Vases of Sweet Peas – each vase containing 9 spikes of a single named variety, each vase a different variety
- B3 One Vase of Sweet Peas – not more than 9 spikes of a single variety
- B4 One bowl of Sweet Peas – own foliage only
