

SECTION E - PLANTS

The C. W. Statham Cup is awarded for the Best Exhibit in Section E

The George H. Morrell Cup is awarded to the exhibitor with the most points in Section E

The Banksian Medal, kindly given by the Royal Horticultural Society, is awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in Sections B, C, D, E, G & H. An exhibitor may not win the medal more than once in three consecutive years. In the event of a tie, the committee will decide the winner.

Guidelines:

- Pots should be placed on a plant saucer to avoid leakage.

CLASSES

- E1 One Flowering Plant
- E2 One Foliage Plant
- E3 One Tuberous Begonia
- E4 One Petunia
- E5 One Fuchsia (any size, bush, trailing or standard)
- E6 One Bonsai
- E7 One Geranium (any variety, regal or zonal)
- E8 One Streptocarpus
- E9 A Container (any size, an arrangement of any plants, flowering and/or foliage.)
- E10 An Edible Container (a pot, window box or basket of edible plants – salad, herbs and/or vegetables)
